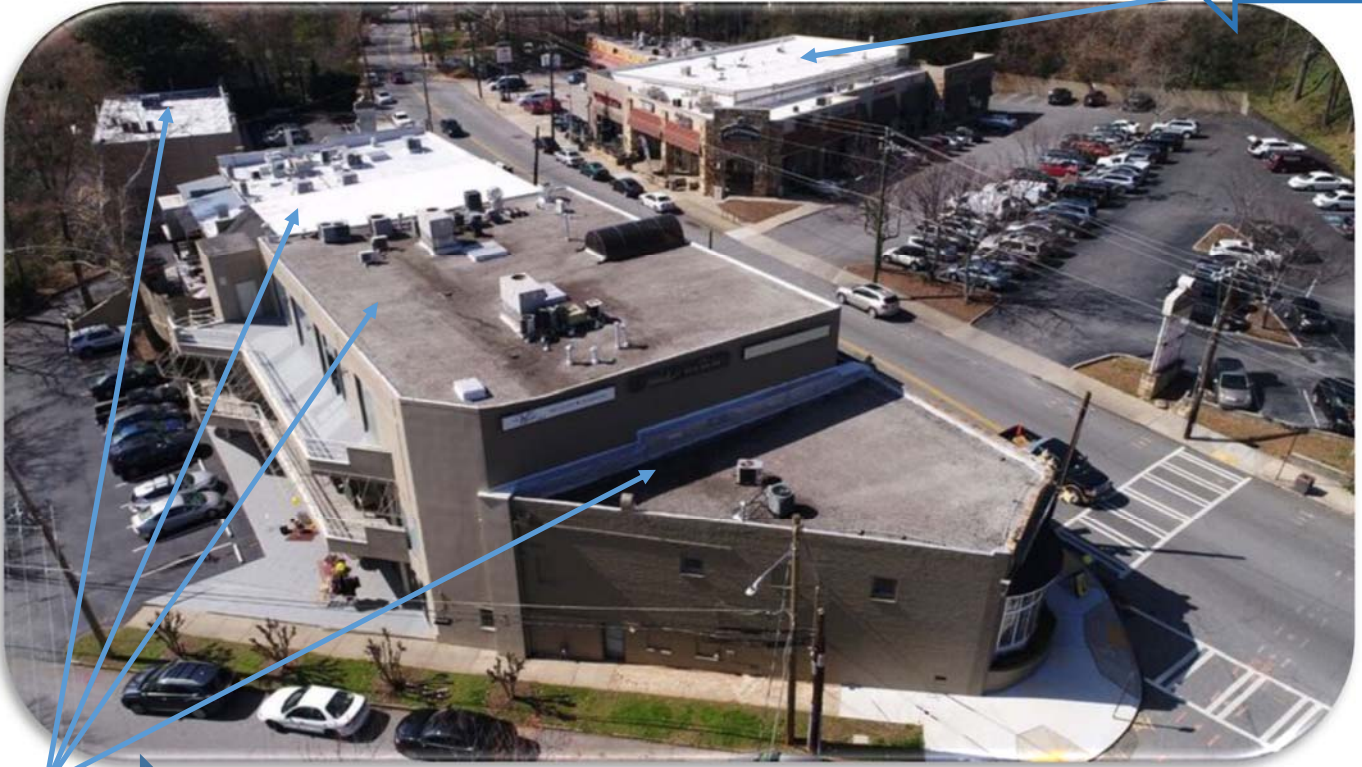

Project Highlight - North Highland Avenue

The buildings in the foreground all have Apollo roofs that are 12-22+ years old. By performing routine roof inspections then completing the recommended repairs, we have kept these roofs going for years. They show no sign of needing to be replaced any time soon and had ZERO leaks this past winter and spring. Routine maintenance always increases roof life and decreases crisis roof leaks making both the tenants and the owners happy as expensive replacement is postponed and crisis leaks rarely occur.

The shining white roof in the right background is a new TPO roof system with high R-value insulation that was just installed by Apollo. It was time to replace the roof we put on the building approximately 32± years ago (one of Apollo's first projects!)



We also do emergency roof leaks all year long and we have lots of foul weather friends – they call us when it is raining!

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PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

*32+ years of wear and tear on a smooth surfaced asphalt built-up roof takes its toll and **the time had finally come for a new roof!** The owner contacted Apollo again. We did a thorough onsite inspection including a moisture scan to determine if any underlying insulation was wet or damaged. A detailed proposal was prepared and a plan of action was generated.*



Roof inspection revealed wet insulation.



Wet insulation that had been identified during the moisture scan was removed from the roof system.



New mechanically fastened insulation with an R-value of 20+ to meet code and tenant demands was installed.



New insulation was also added to the side and top of the wall to provide a smooth roofing surface.



A new wood nailer was added to the top of the parapet wall at the perimeter of the building to accommodate new preformed coping metal.

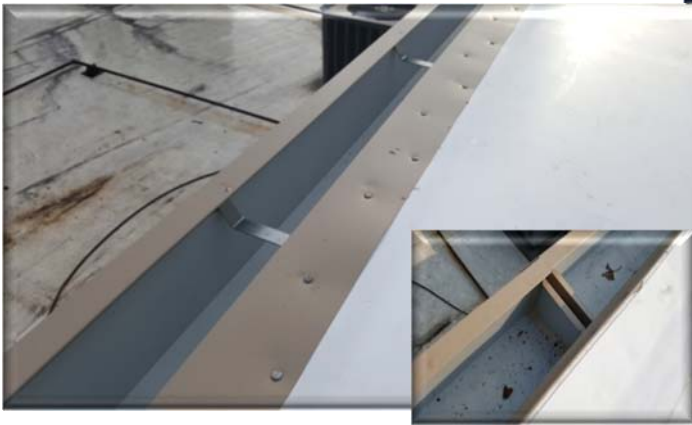


New Kynar finished coping metal was installed along the parapet wall. The standing joints were folded together and sealed to make leaking almost impossible.



60 mil white TPO membrane was then installed and also secured with plates and screws. The seams were heat welded together to form a "continuous" envelope for the roof.

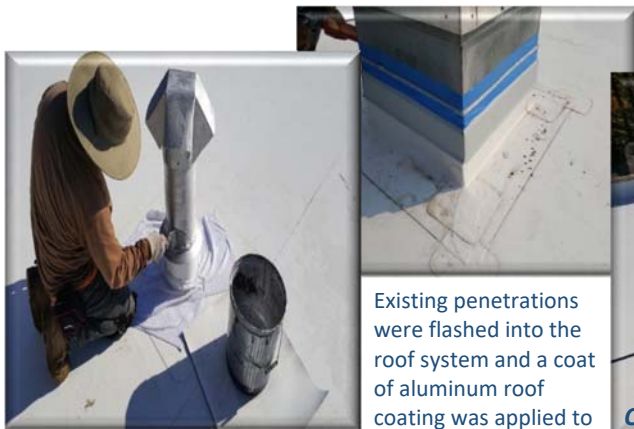
PROJECT HIGHLIGHT (cont)



New Kynar finished 8" box gutters were installed along the rear wall. New edge metal was then installed over the gutter edge, followed by a membrane flashing.



A new grease trap was constructed around a large exhaust unit. The trap was lined with TPO membrane and then filled with sand.

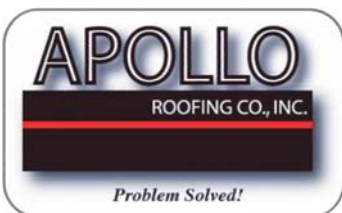


Existing penetrations were flashed into the roof system and a coat of aluminum roof coating was applied to exposed metal to inhibit rust years down the road.
